#### **BRIEF HISTORY- HORSESHOES IN BC**

Organized horseshoe pitching began in British Columbia in 1929. A group of ardent horseshoe enthusiasts from the Lower Mainland and Vancouver Island regions got together that year and organized the first ever provincial championships.

The B.C. Horseshoe Association has been in existence since 1970. Our first president was Robert M. Blunt. Over the years we have gone through a few name changes, originally British Columbia Horseshoe Pitchers Association (BCHPA), followed in the mid 1980's with Horseshoes B.C. before we finally settle on the B.C. Horseshoe Association.

The B.C. Horseshoe Association is a member of Horseshoe Canada, the governing body of horseshoes in Canada.

The Canadian Championships have been held in our province on numerous occasions.

The B.C. Horseshoe Association Hall of Fame is located in the clubhouse of the Central Park Horseshoe Club.

Our season starts in the first weekend in April and concludes on the last weekend of September.

Our Provincial Championships are held each year on the Labor Day Weekend.

**1970** Organizational meeting held. A five-page document called the "CONSTITUTION & BY-LAWS" was adopted and a council of executive directors elected.





. This new organization was then registered as "BRITISH COLUMIBA HORSESHOE PITCHERS' ASSOCIATION"

Membership dues were set at \$2.00 per year, and an official logo designed for the association. The logo is a totem pole circled by a horseshoe with additional surrounding scrolls. The logo appeared on all letterheads during the BOB BLUNT presidency.

Plans were also introduced at that meeting for hosting of a large open – BC INTERNATIONAL in MAY.
