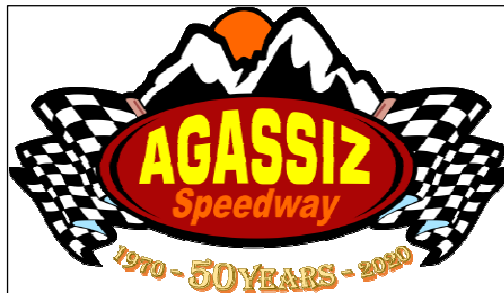

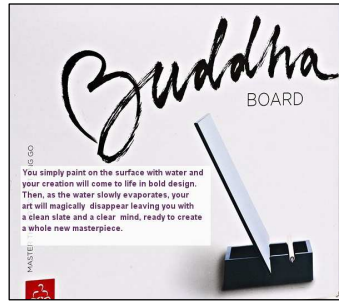

2020 ON-LINE UNSANCTIONED TEAM CHAMPS – SAM TOMASEVIC

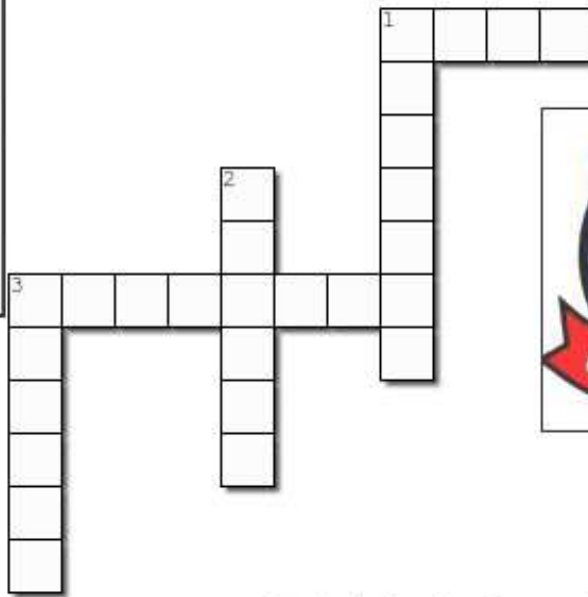
