Moving Forward TOM MOFFAT - PRESIDENT B.C. HORSESHOE ASSOCIATION

With BC moving into phase 2 of the Covid re-opening plan, It is a good time to send a message to all member clubs and players of BC Horseshoe Association.

Its been a long grind the past 15 or so months since Covid sent us home and not being able to get out and play the sport we love, horseshoes. Since then, we have had all kinds of difficulty to get out and do normal things let alone horseshoes. But now we are starting to see the light at the end of the tunnel.

Clubs are starting to get drop ins and leagues started now and some tournaments are started to be planned. It is important that we understand that even though phase 2 lets us do a few more things, your local municipality may add some other restrictions on your club. So please when, planning check with your local government to see where you stand.

BCHA executive has been meeting a few times by zoom to discuss various topics about horseshoes and the one that has been on the top of the list is holding a BC Championships this summer.

We hare making plans to go ahead with the BC Championships, but some things need to happen. We have talked with Abbotsford about holding them on the Labour Day weekend and they are interested in doing this. **But there are some hurdles** we need to get past, before this can happen. We have 3 main points that need to be met before this tournament will happen.

- 1. BC has moved into Phase 3 of the reopening plan (earliest date July 1)
- 2. Abbotsford club and Municipality are on board with us holding this tournament.
- We have a minimum of 45 entries by Aug 1, 2021.
 Actually, all of these points must be met by Aug 1, 2021, and only then will we commit fully to holding the BC Championships.

Not everyone has the same comfort level about getting together so please be patient with one another, no matter what your view on the covid reopening plan.

Remember to get your entries in early, if 45 entries are not received by August 1. 2021we will not proceed.

Details about the tournament will come later but if interested please send in your registration by Aug 1, so we know if the numbers warrant holding a Championships.

Till then stay tune to further updates.




Remember it has been 15 months or so, so come enjoy and forgive any hick ups.


ABBOTSFORD HORSESHOE CLUB – JIM WILLIAMS PRESIDENT

Ken Smorang doing OK, going in for more tests to make sure nothing is clotting near his brain. He is a little weak on his left side.


Danny Coffin is still having problem with his second hip replacement. He will be going to see more specialists.
