Horseshoe Pitching Online offers everyone the chance to compete

All of the horseshoe pitching clubs throughout the region may be closed due to the COVID-19 outbreak, but that doesn't mean residents can't still toss a few ringers.

Victoria resident, and former B.C. men's horseshoe pitching champion, Tom Moffat was keeping his skills polished from from home even before spread of COVID-19 started, by participating in online pitching matches.

"Right now basically everything is cancelled, league, tournaments, everything. So this gives people an opportunity to keep playing," said Moffat. "We play quick, 12-shoe games using Facebook live, count up the points, share our video, and compete against someone, somewhere. It's really an interesting concept, sort of like chess mail."

Moffat started playing online 15 months ago, after he found a Facebook group, Horseshoe Pitching Online, with more than 1,500 members who regularly compete by sharing videos, and create on-going mini leagues and tournaments.

"I just finished up a little league of three-person teams," Moffat noted. "My team won."

Anyone can join in as long as they have a space to play, and can upload videos to Facebook. People who wish to participate also need to have horseshoes, use of a pit in o put in the ground, and throw the shoes from 30 feet away if you're a woman, or 40 feet

their neighbourhood or have a pin to put in the ground, and throw the shoes from 30 feet away if you're a woman, or 40 feet for men.

Some tournaments or leagues cost \$10 to \$15 to enter, but anyone can play at any time by challenging someone to a match and then posting a video of their game.





Though Moffat is a relatively experienced player, having played since 2002, he explained that there are various levels and people can always compete with someone at their own calibre.


"It's special because you can play anyone, anywhere, and you don't have to be part of club," said Moffat, adding that the playing the sport is an inexpensive way to have a lot of fun.

"Horseshoe pitching is great because you can be six years old or you could be 95 and you can still play, it's a sport for absolutely anyone."



Horseshoe Canada will have final call on major tournaments

Two major horseshoe tournaments planned for High Prairie in August 2020 have not yet been cancelled over the worldwide COVID-19 pandemic.

The High Prairie Horseshoe Club is scheduled to host the 2020 Canadian Horseshoe Pitching Championships Aug. 19-22, organized by Horseshoe Canada Association in partnership with the Alberta Horseshoe Pitchers Association AHPA.

Before that, High Prairie plans to host the Western Canadian Horseshoe Classic from Aug 14-16.

"As far as we know at this time, the Canadian championships and the Western Canadian Classic are still a go," club president Ray Prevost says March 23.

"Horseshoe Canada makes the decision." He expects a final decision will be made before June.

"My biggest concern is that we lose both tournaments altogether," says Prevost, second vice-president of the AHPA.



"We've put in a lot of work the last three years to get the nationals."

He is still optimistic High Prairie will host the national championships.

"We hope is that if it is cancelled in 2020, we can host the tournament in 2021," says Prevost.

"We're hoping, it's still up in the air.

"We've put everything on hold."

Before the pandemic, Prevost and organizers predicted big numbers for participants and visitors to the region during the tournaments.

"We expect 200-300 competitors for each tournament," Prevost says.

AHTA president Cindy Ekkel gives the High Prairie area top marks for plans to host the nationals. "Community support for horseshoes in High Prairie has always been excellent," Ekkel says.

"It's quite an accomplishment if you look at an event that could attract up to 200 competitors."

Prevost says organizers have raised more than \$20,000 in prize money for the national tournament to attract more competitors.

Organizers predict each horseshoe tournament could create an influx of several hundred tourists to High Prairie.

Ekkel says Prevost and the club are doing a great job to promote the event and the sport of horseshoes.






With that said, not all of you have a phone to record games or comfortable doing that. So we have come up with an email tournament in BC

This is open to anyone to play wherever you can. Your back yard, a park or club that isn't closed to playing. Its free to enter, deadline for the first one is May 1 then you have 1 week to pitch 5-30 shoe games counting ringers only. Just email results in of # or ringers for each game. Example Ringers 20, 21,16,10,15. There will be divisions for 40ft men, Elders, and Ladies. If not competitive enough some classes will be mixed. We hope to get a lot of people from Canada and USA to enter. Its just for fun and you have to be honest. You play your games between May 1 and May 8. 6 person classes, wins and losses round robin style. Ties will count as ties. All ties in standings will be decided by ringer % even for first place. Canstats or Natstats percent will be used to place in classes. Non sanctioned players can play with 3-30 shoe games prior to entry on May 1.
