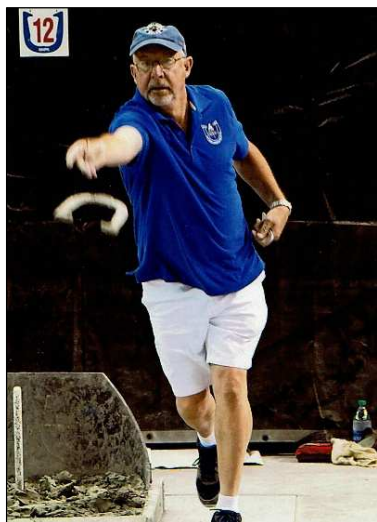

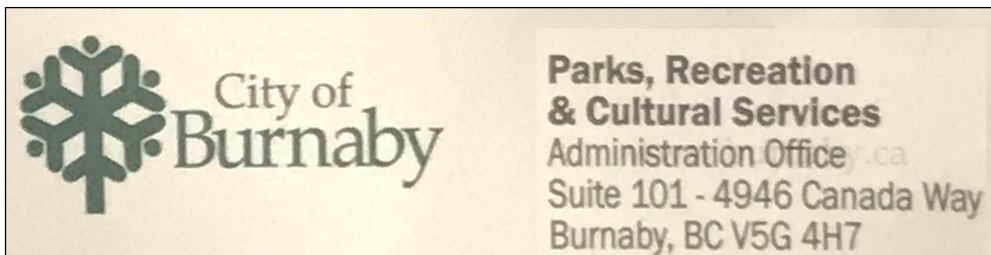

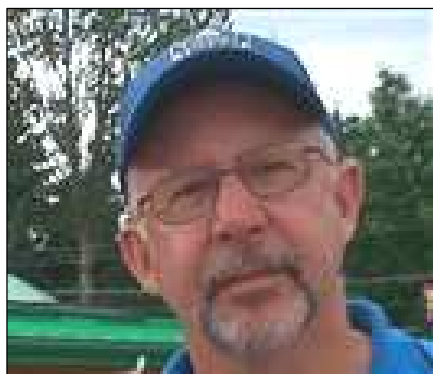


Pitching!!
