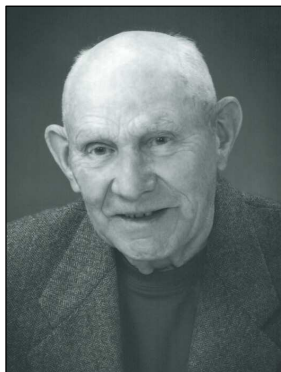

1. A PIONEER PASSES AWAY – JACK ADAMS



The family of Jack Adams is sad to announce his passing in Saskatoon on May 25, 2020 at the age of 98. Uncle Jack was born in Saskatoon on October 18, 1921 to Arthur and Katherine Adams. He was predeceased by his wife Olive in 1991, sister Joan Finney in 2011, brother Donald (Pete) in 2012 and brother Bruce (Jim) in 2015. He is survived by three nephews, Doug, James and Jack Adams, all of Saskatoon. Jack graduated from the University of Saskatchewan with a degree in engineering in 1944 and immediately joined the military which took him across Canada, Europe and the United States. He retired in 1972 with the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. In 1976, he moved back to Saskatoon where he was involved in horseshoe pitching, curling, lawn bowling as both a participant and organizer. 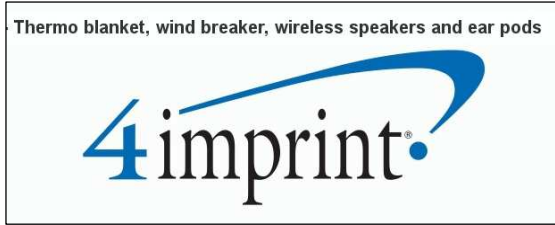

So all sanctioned tournaments and awards this year will be put on hold for the time being, with one exception we will be Awarding a Presidents Award to Jack Adams whom has just passed in Saskatoon for his past help when BC Horseshoes was just forming.

This is a trying and frustrating time without playing our usual leagues and tournaments and drop in play for clubs around BC. With the Covid-19 shutdown and now the slow progression to Phase 2 we the BC Horseshoe

Association executive have been working on how to help clubs get back to playing.

So moving forward the executive is now working hard on coming up with a document to go to all clubs on Guidelines on back to play. This must be a comprehensive document so will take a few days to get it right. We don't want to go backwards so we will make sure its right to start. This will be for all clubs to follow to help them get back to some casual play at this time. Please be patient we will get this to you as soon as possible. We want to see you back at the courts throwing some shoes this year.


If any club has sent a proposal for back to safe playing to their municipalities or government body if you could share the proposal with BC Horseshoes it would be most helpful in our understanding of all clubs situations with us writing our guidelines for back to play for horseshoes.

I want to thank all of you for your continued patience at this time and we the executives of BC Horseshoes sure miss seeing each and every one of you this year. With that said we look forward to better times ahead and some wonderful games of horseshoes. Tom Moffat,
