Open Discussion: Secretary-Treasurer Brian Ryder spoke to the meeting about a recommendation that the BCHA Executive would like to make with respect to BCHA members (Excluding Provincial Members) having to participate in a minimum of two sanctioned tournaments in the previous 12 month prior to the B.C. International or the B.C. Championships in order to be eligible to participate in these tournaments. Discussion took place with members in attendance at the meeting with respect to the rationale for the recommendation and how the Executive would deal with Provincial Members.

It was moved by Brian Ryder and seconded by Gail Bishop, that all BCHA members (Excluding Provincial Members) would be required to participate in at least two sanctioned tournaments in the previous 12 months prior to the B.C. International starting 2023 and the B.C. Championships starting 2022. Carried
