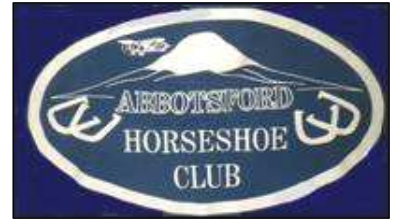

## **2018 BC INTERNATIONAL/HIGHWAYMAN OPEN**

As a participant, you are expected to know the "Official Rules of Play" We hope you enjoy pitching in this horseshoe tournament.

### **PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING**

Win-Loss records shall determine the final class standings. A tie for first place will be decided by a playoff. All other position ties will be decided by tournament ringer percentage.

The B.C. HORSESHOE ASSOCIATION would like to welcome you as a participant in the 2018 BC INTERNATIONAL/HIGHWAYMAN OPEN.

### **DURING PLAY**

No alcohol, tobacco of any kind, or e-cigarettes shall be permitted within the confines of the courts at any time. Cell phones must be in silent mode.

All pitchers are required to turn (water only if needed), one end of the court once you have completed your game. No permanent marks are allowed to be placed on the walkways.

At the beginning of each game, when both players are ready, they may pitch four (4) warm-up shoes each. Fouls lines will be monitored by judges and they have the authority to remove any shoe pitched in which they observed a foul line violation.

The 30 second time limit in which to pitch both shoes will also be enforced.

Be courteous to your opponent and also those playing on courts next to you. Stand at least two feet behind and on the opposite side of the platform as your opponent when not pitching.

Short distance pitchers are required to move to the rear of the 40 foot platform if adjacent to a full distance class.

Players should have measurement tools. A judge can be called if the two players cannot determine the score or disagree. Judges calls are final.

### **AFTER COMPETITION**

Check the results. If you believe there is an error, notify the Tournament Director and/or the Computer Room Director immediately.

Results errors must be reported within 15 minutes of the official stats room posting of the paper copy on the results bulletin board.

All claims will be evaluated and the decision of the Directors will be final.

Entries received with a postmark after May 14th shall be put on a waiting list and entered into the tournament only as space is available. All adults must have pitched in a minimum of four (4) US/Canadian sanctioned events in the twelve (12) months **prior to May 14, 2018**, in the same division you are entering. Only one (1) event is required for Juniors. Exceptions for US Armed Forces members and family and foreign competitors (other than Canadians) are outlined in Rule 11, Sec D.1 of the RGS Book. Contact NHPA for more information regarding qualifying exceptions. All averages used will be the average on record in NATSTATS / CANSTATS as of May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

Anyone qualifying under an exception must have those scores recorded by the same date. All NHPA and any special tournament rules apply. NHPA and CANADIAN entrants must show their 2018 membership card when checking in. You may enter at anytime prior to May 14<sup>th</sup>. Please see note regarding refunds.

**READ CAREFULLY:** Any adult male pitching from the full distance platform may enter the **OPEN MEN'S DIVISION** regardless of age, just as any adult female may enter the **OPEN WOMEN'S DIVISION**. To enter the **SENIOR DIVISION**, you must be 60 years of age or older before the end of 2018. Any man that turns 70 years of age in 2018, is older than 70, or has an **approved medical exemption** may enter the **ELDER MEN'S DIVISION**. Entrants in the **JUNIOR BOY and JUNIOR GIRL DIVISION** must be 18 years old or less for the entire 2018 calendar year. **JUNIOR CADET DIVISION** entrants must be 12 years old or younger for the entire 2018 calendar year.

**Note # 1.** 30ft Men with Medical Exemptions **must** include a copy of their NHPA Charter Acceptance letter to verify your eligibility to participate in this division. ( Can be obtained from your Charter Secretary. )

**Note # 2.** For class play, a minimum of 48 must enter this division or it will be canceled. All entrants will then pitch in the Open Preliminaries.

**Note # 3** Junior and Cadet divisions will be mixed for preliminary play.

The pitching schedule will be finalized **approximately two (2) weeks after the deadline** and published on the NHPA website. If you indicated above to receive the schedule by mail, it will be mailed to the address you have listed above during the first week in June.

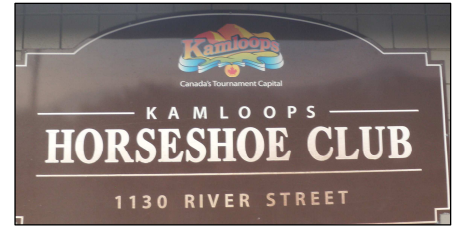
